Our service helps clients to minimise wastage. In addition we will seek to:

- Continue to minimise waste by requesting our suppliers to minimise packaging, by reusing containers and canisters.
- Buy in bulk and control substance transfer procedures in order to both minimise packaging and reduce waste.
- Where possible and in adherence with safety measures, we will rework, repair and reuse, rather than dispose of equipment in order to minimise the cost to the customer and the effects of disposal.
- Continue to closely monitor job schedules to reduce the number of vehicle journeys undertaken.
- Ensure all of our vehicles are regularly tuned and maintained to reduce fuel consumption and emissions to air.
- Where possible, tailor a journey plan for to allow for jobs and site surveys in the same area to be carried out on a single trip.
- Maintain a web site to encourage customers to place orders or send enquiries using electronic mail.
- Recycle card and paper as we are able to.
- Ensure that all our staff show an appropriate level of environmental awareness. This relates particularly to the management of spill and leaks.
- Comply with all relevant legislation, regulations and applicable codes of practice;
